ROLE:

There are 3 roles:

Setting up

Serving refreshments

Volunteering within the session

WHAT EACH ROLE INVOLVES:

Helping with setting up the session at 9am on a Tuesday morning, this involves getting out small and large toys, chairs, tables and craft equipment.

Make and serve coffee and tea for adults attending the group. Make and serve water and toast for children half way through the group. To be available from 9:15 on a rostered basis (usually once a month).

Helping with the set up of the toys and craft, engaging in conversation with the adults and children in the group and to help with the smooth running of the group.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE:

The energy to lift and shift tables!

Ability to make a good cup of tea/coffee (training given if required!) and to serve with a smile.

A welcoming smile and an ability to work as part of a team.

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED:

For all roles:

On the job training provided by a member of the Rainbow Tots team.

Team gatherings at the beginning of the Autumn term and through the year.
