- What do you think is the difference between being passive and actively expectant about God working in power?
- Theologian Clark Pinnock wrote in his book "Flame of love",
"Like Jesus, the church must live not out of its own resources but by the power of the indwelling Spirit."
What might this look like for us here at KPC?
- What do we notice about the first disciples after the Holy Spirit fell on them?
What was the impact?
- How do you feel about the idea that Jesus has transferred power to you to enable you to be vehicle of God's saving love and power?
- What do you think is happening in Acts 3 that makes this ordinary encounter extraordinary?
Have you ever been part of such an encounter yourself?
- How hungry are you/ we really for God to show us his power here in Knowle and pour out a fresh anointing upon us?
- Where might be need to make more room for the Holy Spirit (so that we maintain contact with the 3rd rail of the underground line?)
- What do you make of Spurgeon's claim that *"Self-sufficiency is one of the devil's main temptations."*
