- What impresses you about Peter and John in this incident?
- Have you ever felt under pressure to silence your voice about Jesus? Tell the group a bit about it.
- How much of an appetite do you think we have in church to share Jesus more boldly and see signs and wonders like the apostles in Acts 4?

- What does God's sovereignty mean for you?
- What do you think it might mean to have 'timid convictions' about God?
- How might the connection work between bold, vital witness and fervent prayer and worship? What would that look like in Knowle?
- What has your attitude tended to be towards the idea of praying to be filled with the Holy Spirit? How does this passage maybe challenge you in this regard?
- *"Ordinary people can do extraordinary things when resourced by the Holy Spirit."* In what ways does this tally with your experience?
- How would you like to see KPC being a bit bolder in its life and ministry?
