

Children's Ministry: Midweek activities helper

MINISTRY VISION/PURPOSE:

We want to see our children and families growing in love and trust of Jesus, enjoying exploring their faith, engaging in intergenerational worship and generously serving their community.



ROLE: Midweek Activities helper

WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

Midweek activities may be either during the school day or after school – we run different events in different seasons. Any regular activities during the school day are likely to be during the lunch break and will involve working with a small group of children as they participate in the wider group with Bible stories, crafts and games etc. After school activities may take a variety of formats but again will generally involve supporting the Children's Ministry team in working with small groups of children as they participate in the wider activity / event. This may also involve a refreshment team.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE:

A heart for sharing the good news of Jesus with those who don't already attend church and an understanding of how that might be different in different settings. Good communication skills – both with children and adults; the ability to build relationships.

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED:

An enhanced DBS check is required. Initial Safeguarding Training followed by regular updates is also essential.
