MINISTRY VISION/PURPOSE:

We want to see our children and families growing in love and trust of Jesus, enjoying exploring their faith, engaging in intergenerational worship and generously serving their community.

ROLE:

Sunday Groups helper



WHAT ROLE INVOLVES:

Being on a rota for Sunday groups which run during the 9:30 service. Where possible we try to make sure people only do once a month, but you are of course welcome to do more! There are different ages to work with and different levels of responsibility. Our Sunday groups are made up of creche, toddlers and scramblers —which is for those in school Nursery and Reception - and then Y1&2, Y3&4, and Y5&6. Each week we aim for a key leader who has overall responsibility for that day, sometimes with some preparation to do and support leaders who support the key leaders in engaging with the children, encouraging them to participate etc.

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES FOR ROLE:

A heart for seeing children grow in their faith and recognising that each child's journey is different. Good communication skills – both with children and adults; the ability to build relationships.

TRAINING/GUIDANCE PROVIDED:

An enhanced DBS check must be completed. Initial Safeguarding Training followed by regular updates is also essential.

There are volunteer role descriptions available which contain more detail.

Resource material is provided for Sunday groups where planning is involved for volunteers.
