- What's your reaction to the story here of what God does with Gideon's army? How would your personality have coped?
- What do you think it's important to remember when we feel when the odds are against us?
- What was the lesson that Gideon learned that day about how God resources his people?
- What parallels are there with the feeding of the 5000?
- In what sense do you agree or disagree that all churches never think they have enough resources? Is this true of us at KPC?
- How do we overcome our fears and to grow in confidence in God's enabling and in the exercise of the gifts he's given to each of us? What things block this from happening?
- *"Neither all of him or all of us."* Where would you put KPC on a scale between where we think we need to do everything and letting God get the job done?
- Thinking about our post- covid future as a church, how prepared do you think we are to do things God's way?
