

Questions for home groups (Ephesians 3: 7-13)

- Have you ever been tempted to give up on church? If so, you might like to share when and why this was.
- What is it for you that makes church central to God's purposes for the world?
- What should it mean for us at KPC that Jesus has broken down every dividing wall of hostility? How should this effect the way our church feels?
- What might it mean for us to be displayers of God's wisdom to the world (*verse 10*)? What might that look like?
- In what sense do we expect God to do remarkable things through us as a church? Where's the balance between servicing our own needs and serving those outside our walls?
- Gathered church / scattered church – where have you tended to place your emphasis in your understanding of church?
- What do you make of the idea that every Christian is a missionary and has their own mission field?
- Where might your mission field be in normal and pandemic times?
- How can church best equip you for life during the rest of the week?
