- How does Jesus redefine our expectation of how God operates in the world?
- What might a “kindness revolution” (Gerard Kelly) look like here in Knowle?
- If it’s true that progress in the Christian life is marked above all else by progress in love’ how do you think we’re doing in KPC?
- Some people argue that there should be a bias to the poor in the way we serve? In what way do you agree or disagree?
- Who might be the poor in our area?
- What do you make of the claim that “kindness to self is crucial in becoming a conduit of kindness to others”?  
How hard do you find it to be kind to yourself?
- What dangers do you see in pouring ourselves out for others? How do we get the balance right?
- What would the effect be of the KPC community being seen as a movement of servant love?
